This Indenture made this twelfth day of June one thousand eight hundred between Matthew Amey of Botetown County of the one part & Samuel Baker of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Matthew Amey in consideration of twelve pounds of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Baker at or before executing & delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained & sold, & by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Samuel Baker his Heirs & assigns a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying on both sides fork of Glade Creek in Botetown County containing Eleven Acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at Amey's corner W. C. Ash thence with his patent line N 2 W 53 poles to a white oak in a lane & close to Arnold's fence. Thence off dividing lines S 67 W 48 poles crossing the said Creek to a small sower wood S 15 E 20 poles to two pointers two W. oaks & a small pine in the patent line thence with the patent lines S 62 E 26 to an old corner 100 ash (now a oak) by the edge of said Creek S 36 E 13 poles crossing the Creek to the Beginning together with all & singular the appurtenances therunto belonging to the same or any part thereof & the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders yearly & other rents issues & profits thereof & of every part & parcel thereof.
