This Indenture made the ninth Day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven Hundred and Ninety three. Between Alexander Forbes and Jane his wife of Bedford County and State of Virginia. Mathew Amack and Catrine his wife, and Samuel Amack and Elenore his wife of Botetourt County and State aforesaid of the one part and John Ratchin of Campbell County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that they the said Alexander Forbes, Mathew Amack and Samuel Amack and their wives for and in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said John Ratchin and his Heirs and Assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land, containing four hundred Acres of Land, (more or less) situate lying and being in Campbell County aforesaid on Western branches of the South fork of Falling River, and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at Andrew Mainstons corner white Oak, thence South ten degrees West thirty two Poles to a pine, South thirty three Degrees East thirty poles to a Red Oak, South thirty six poles crossing broad branch to pointors on the brow of a hill, South thirty six degrees West forty eight Poles to a shrub white Oak, South sixty Degrees West twenty four Poles to a small Red Oak, South twenty six degrees West twenty four poles to a pine, South eighty degrees West one hundred poles to a pine, North forty two poles to pointors, North sixty three Degrees, West two Hundred and fifty six poles to a black jack near a path, South seventy degrees West fifty eight Poles to pointors in Andrew Mainstons line, thence along his line North thirty six degrees, West one Hundred poles to his corner small white Oak on the old line of Oensby, thence along the old line, North seventy eight degrees East one Hundred and sixty poles to his corner pine. North thirty four degrees East one hundred and thirty two Poles to a corner pine, thence along Mainstons line, South seventy degrees East sixty six poles to his corner pine, South twenty nine degrees, East seventy four poles to his corner pine, South twelve degrees East sixty two poles to his corner hickory, North sixty eight degrees East fifty six poles to his corner shrub white Oak, South fifty nine Degrees East forty eight poles to his corner pine and North eighty seven degrees East fourteen poles to the first station granted to Andrew Mainston by Patent and made over to them the said Alex Forbes, Mathew and Saml Amack and their wives by Deed. To have and to hold the said four Hundred Acres of Land hereditaments and Premises hereby granted or mentioned to be granted with the appurtenances privileges Rents Issues and proffits unto the said John Ratchin his Heirs and Assigns forever, and the sd Alex Forbes, Mathew and Saml Amack and their wives and their Heirs the said four Hundred Acres of Land and Premises shall warrant and forever defend unto the said John Ratchin his Heirs and Assigns. Donald, Whereas Benjamin Arthur of Campbell County by a certain Deed of Trust now in the Office of Campbell County Court proved by one Witness did make, over and convey unto Christopher Clark of Bedford County a certain tract or parcel of Land, as particularly described in the said Deed for the purpose of securing a Debt due to me by the said Arthur, and whereas I have received from the said Arthur full satisfaction for the said Debt, now KNOW all men by these presents that I do hereby release, relinquish and renounce all title claim or Interest which I have had, or in any wise can have or demand, in and to the said tract of Land, and Acknowledge that the said Debt for which the said Deed was given is now fully discharged and satisfied.
