**His Indenture** made the fourth day of September One thousand seven hundred and eighty three Between Elizabeth Hairston Adm<sup>or</sup>. of Andrew Hairston Deceased Alexander Forbes and Jenny his Wife Matthew Amos and Catharine his Wife Samuel Amos and Elanor his Wife Pyscilla Hairston Margaret Hairston and Susanna Hairston Legatees of the said Andrew Hairston Decd. of the One part and James Shearer of the County of Campbell of the Other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Andrew Hairston by his last Will and Testament Recorded in the County Court of Campbell did Among other things direct that all his Lands lying and being in the said County should be sold and the Money arising from such Sale to be divided Among the Legatees Aforesaid in such manner as by the said Will is directed. upon which Sale the said James Shearer Purchased for the sum of Eighty one pounds Current Money of Virginia the receipt of which is Acknowledged One tract or parcel of the said Land containing Four Hundred acres by Patent bearing date the first day of September A. D. C. L. X. X. C. lying on the Head branches of Dogwood branch and Bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at John Dales and South Corner Pine at a branch thence along Dales lines South seventy five degrees East One hundred and seventy poles to his Corner pine South forty two degrees East one hundred and four Poles to his and Heaths Corner pine thence along Heaths lines North forty six poles to his Corner white Oak North Twenty two degrees West forty six poles to his Corner Red Oak North five degrees East One Hundred and forty six poles to his Corner black Jack North forty degrees East Sixty Poles to his Corner pine thence off North thirty six degrees West Two Hundred and fifty poles to a small white Oak on Arnolds line thence along his lines South eighty degrees West one Hundred and forty two Poles to his Corner pine South forty Degrees West seventy two Poles to Dales Corner small white Oak thence along Dales lines South sixty seven degrees East Two Hundred and four Poles to his Corner large white Oak on a branch South Twenty two degrees East One Hundred and thirty two poles to his Corner Pine South sixty five degrees West One Hundred and fifty poles to his Corner pine and South Thirteen degrees West Twenty four poles to the first Station.
