in the County of Lancaster for which he agrees to pay to our Use at the rate of Fifteen Pounds Ten Shillings current Money of this Province for each Hundred Acres, and the yearly Quit-rent of one Half-penny Sterling for every Acre thereof; THESE are therefore to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Neal M^c Calister at the Place aforesaid, according to the Method of Townships appointed, the said Quantity of 230 Acres, if not already survey'd or appropriated, and make Return thereof into the Secretary's Office, in order for further Confirmation; for which this shall be thy sufficient Warrant; which Survey, in Case the said Neal M^c Calister fulfil the above Agreement within Six Months from the Date hereof, shall be valid, otherwise void.
