Peter Horstones nine Years ago in the *County of Samcastor* for which *he* agrees to pay to our Use *At the rate of* Fifteen Pounds Ten Shillings current Money of this Province for *each* *_____* Hundred Acres, and the yearly Quit-rent of one Half-penny Sterling for every Acre thereof; THESE are therefore to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said *Neal M^c Calister* at the Place aforesaid, according to the Method of Townships appointed, the said Quantity of *230* Acres, if not already survey'd or appropriated, and make Return thereof into the Secretary's Office, in order for further Confirmation; for which this shall be thy sufficient Warrant; which Survey, in Case the said *Neal M^c Calister* fulfil the above Agreement within *Six* Months from the Date hereof, shall be valid, otherwise void.
