 that if the above bounden Michael Rowland his heirs  
 and Successors shall well and Truly build a prison in said  
 County of Pennsylvania convenient to the said Court  
 Houses of the following plan and size Viz<sup>t</sup>. a prison . . .  
 Twenty four feet by sixteen seven feet between floors  
 the body to be built of good Sawed or hewn plank twelve  
 Inches thick the floors of said size and sort of Timber  
 covered with good nail shingles three good doors in  
 convenient parts of said prison the inside of said  
 prison to be set with oak plank Inch and a half  
 thick nail on with half crown nails the doors of said  
 prison to have sufficient locks to each of them all so  
 three windows in said prison well barred with Iron Grates  
 sufficient to keep out assistance to Rescue either by  
 or holes also a good Chimney in convenient part  
 of said prison well Iron Grated above and below all  
 and every part of said prison to be done and finished  
 in the term of six month Months from the date hereof  
 to the satisfaction of said Court of Pennsylvania now if  
 the said work be done finished agreeable to the plan  
 mentioned then this obligation to be void otherwise  
 to remain in force power and Virtue
