parole of honor, that I will not oppose
or conspire against the Constitution of
the United States, nor against the
authorities thereof, Civil or Military; nor
will I incite sedition or rebellion against
the same, and that I will not give aid
or comfort or information to the so-
called Confederate army, nor to any one
co-operating therewith, and that I will
not pass beyond the limits prescribed in
this permit; and that I will not directly
or indirectly violate this, my Parole,
upon penalty of death.
