To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Ann Hairston and Ezekiel Hairston of Montgomery County have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Cahaba whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Ann Hairston and Ezekiel Hairston according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands;" for the South West quarter of Section Six, in Township fifteen, of Range twenty one, in the district of Lands subject to sale at Cahaba Alabama, containing one hundred and sixty acres and sixty two hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Ann Hairston and Ezekiel Hairston

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Ann Hairston and Ezekiel Hairston and to their heirs, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Ann Hairston and Ezekiel Hairston and to their heirs and assigns forever. as Tenants in common and not of joint tenants
