This Indenture made this 19th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eight, between Matthew Amyx Senior of Botetourt County & State of Virginia of the one part, and William Wallace of the said County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Matthew Amyx for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand eight hundred & eighty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Wallace, the receipt whereof ^{he hath} by these presents acknowledge, hath granted bargain & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said William Wallace a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by Survey Two hundred & Sixteen Acres be the same more or less as is contained within the boundaries hereafter mentioned — part thereof is part of a tract of 395 acres which was granted to his father Matthew Amyx Deceased by patent bearing date the first day of August 17 in the 12th year of the reign of George the 3^d & the said Matthew Amyx in his lifetime conveyed the said to the said Matthew his Son by deed bearing date the 19th day of December 1778

And the residue of the said tract of 216 acres is part of a tract of 59 acres which was granted to the said Matthew Amyx by patent bearing date the 4th day of July 1795 — the said tract of two hundred & Sixteen Acres lies in the county aforesaid on Grubbs gap branch off which is a branch of glade creek waters of Roanoke river and the same is bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a Chest stake corner to the Land of the heirs of James Amyx Dec^d & on a line of the said Grant of 395 acres & runneth thence with the said line North 1 Degree West 95 1/2 poles to a ~~corner~~ stake one pole east of a black oak Corner to the Land of Samuel Amyx Senior, thence with the same South 87 Degrees West 31 poles to a white oak & Spanish oak South 88 Degrees West 234 poles crossing the branch, and passing three black oaks & a white oak on the outside line Corner to Andrew Amyx's New Survey & with the same & the said grant of 59 acres to a double & single black oak thence with the grant of 59 acres South 89 Degrees West 16 poles to a Black oak and chestnut oak added — South 10 Degrees West 106 poles passing near four hickories & a white oak saplings to a pine & black oak, South 32 1/2 Degrees East 23 poles to near two pines, ~~black oak~~ corner to the heirs of James Amyx Dec^d & thence with a line of the same North 82 Degrees East 300 poles crossing the branch to the Beginning. . . . To have & to hold the said tract of 216 Acres of Land & premises together with all & singular the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said William Wallace and to the sole use & behoof of the said William Wallace & his heirs forever and the said Matthew Amyx Senior for himself & his heirs Executors & administrators the said tract of Land with every advantage & privilege therunto belonging or in any way appertaining from himself & his heirs and all persons whatsoever unto the said William Wallace & his heirs or assigns shall & will forever warrant & defend by these presents in testimony whereof the said Matthew Amyx Senior hath hereunto set his hand & Seal the day & year first above written. . . . N.B. the words, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm was interlined in the ninth line of this deed before it was signed
