

EXPLANATION

The school year is divided into six terms of six weeks each. At the end of the third term and at the end of the sixth term examinations will be held. The annual average is found by averaging the term averages and the examination averages.

P, 100 is perfect; E, excellent, 90 to 100; V G, very good, 85 to 90; G, good, 75 to 84; F, fair, 65 to 74; U, unsatisfactory, below 65. Below 65 per cent. is very poor work. An average of not less than 65 per cent. on any one subject and an annual average of 75 per cent. are required for promotion. In finding monthly averages count conduct and punctuality one.
