of which I have been allwaies a faithfull though an unworthy member
I give I lend to my well beloved wife Elisabeth Hopkins the following Slaves
for & during her Natural Life together with y^e Plantation whereon
I now live with all y^e appurtenances thereunto belonging to wit Tom
Patt: Subo: Jude. and I add to the Plantation that is now cleant
one Thousand Acres for the Support of it. provided She Accepts this
Gift in lieu of her Dower I also give her one third part of all my
Cattel Hogs & other my Personal Estate excepting the Value of any of
my Lands which I shall hereafter direct to be sold by my Executors
hereafter named and my Books & Medicines.
I give I confer to my Son Samuel all the Slaves in his Possession as also
all my Lands on Cumingham Creeke for which I have already made
Him a Deede.
I give & bequeath to my Son John all my Lands in the County of Goochland
as also all the Slaves in his Possession to him & his Heirs for ever
