Witnesseth that the said John Harvey for & in Consideration of Forty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in Hand paid the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained sold Released and Confirmed by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell Release & Confirm unto the said Peter Holland to his Heirs and assigns for Ever one certain tract of Land containing three Hundred & Ninety two acres lying & being in the County of Bedford on the south side of Goose Creek & bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a gum on the said Creek just below opposite to his old upper Corner thence new line North fifty degrees west two hundred & fifty four poles to a Hickory south forty degrees west two Hundred & twenty poles crossing Roaring Run to a White oak south fifty degrees East one Hundred & forty six poles to a White oak North forty degrees east four poles to a White oak on a Branch thence down the said Branch as it Meanders to Goose Creek & thence up Goose Creek as it Meanders to the first Station with all woods swamps Meadows and other Profits & Commodities to the same belonging of all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim & demand whatsoever of him the said John Harvey of in & to the said Land & Premises every part thereof to have and to hold the said tract of land & all the above granted & promised with their appurtenances unto the said Peter Holland
