


November 8, 1777.

Surveyed for Andrew Hairston 100 Acres of Land situate in Bedford County on both sides of Burn Bridge Branch, of Beaver Creek, on both sides of the main Road; and Bounded as followeth, viz, Beginning at the Gaffy Jun<sup>t</sup> Corner Pine, near the Long Mountain at A, th from, A to B, N $78^{\circ}$  E, 16 poles to a Shrub White



B to C, S $45^{\circ}$  E, 16 poles to Pointers C to D, N $55^{\circ}$  E, 32 poles to a Spanish D to E, N $7^{\circ}$  E, 52 poles to a Bunch of Che E to F, N $50^{\circ}$  E, 52 poles to a Chestnut Q F to G, E-, 32 poles to a black gum G to H, N $32^{\circ}$  E, 92 poles to a Bunch Chestnuts on Hylton's Line: H to I, along his Line N $30^{\circ}$  W, 72 poles to his Corner Black Oak: thence off. from I to K, N $50^{\circ}$  W, 80 poles to a Red Oak K to L, S $40^{\circ}$  W, 72 poles to a Pine L to M, S $20^{\circ}$  W, 66 poles to a Pine M to N, S $70^{\circ}$  W, 18 poles to a Pine N to O, N $20^{\circ}$  W, 116 poles to a Double Pine O to P, S $70^{\circ}$  W, 200 poles to Pointers P to Q, S $20^{\circ}$  E, 120 poles to Pointers on

Line: thence along his lines, from, Q to R, N $73^{\circ}$  E, 38 poles to his Cor. R to S, S $16^{\circ}$  E, 31 poles to his Corner Pointers. S to T, N $85^{\circ}$  E, 5 to his Corner two Chestnuts: T to V, S $63^{\circ}$  E, 10 poles to his Corner P. V to W, S $44^{\circ}$  E, 50 poles to his Corner Pine: and W to A, S $31^{\circ}$  E, poles to the first Station.

situate in Bedford County on both sides of Irvine's Road, near head West Branches of Flat Creek; and Bounded as followeth, viz, Beg at Irvine's Corner Shrub White Oak on Anthony's Line about along Anthony's Lines, A to B, N $63^{\circ}$  W, 230 po. to his Cor. on B to C, S $30^{\circ}$  E, 120 poles to his and Mook's Corner White Oak: Mook's Lines, C to D, S $22^{\circ}$  E, 74 po. to his Cor. Red Oak: D S-, 25 poles to Irvine's Corner Pointers: thence along Irvine E to F, E-, 15 poles to his corner small Shrub White F to A, N $45^{\circ}$  E, 120 poles to the first Station.
