Commonwealth of Virginia, To all to whom these Presents shall
come greeting Know ye, that in consideration of the an-
cient composition of twenty five shillings sterling Paid
by Samuel Hairston into the Treasury of this Commonwealth there
is granted by the said Commonwealth unto the said Samuel
Hairston a certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing by Survey
bearing date the Eighteenth day of December one Thousand Seven
hundred and fifty four, Two Hundred and forty Nine Acre &
being in the County of Bedford on both Sides Bever Creek and bound-
ed as followeth, to wit, Beginning at a white oak on a Branch
Running thence North twenty three West seventy one Poles to a
Red oak then North fifty West sixty three Poles to Pointers thence North
Nineteen West forty four Poles to a white oak then North Eighty
West thirty eight Poles to his own Line at a heap of Stones then
with his own Line South three and a half East ten Poles to Point-
ers then West one hundred and ten Poles to a white oak then
new lines South forty West fifty three Poles to a Pine
then South twenty five East seventy one Poles to a Pine then
South one hundred and Eight Poles to a Pine then North
Seventy eight East one hundred and thirty Nine Poles
