sworn before some Justice of the peace) down the mine branch by the widow via to Smiths
River to intersect with a view for a road from Franklin County and report to Court their
action thereupon

them, be appointed commissioners, being first sworn before some Justice of the peace to settle
the account current of Martin Colord and John Boyd administrators of Joshua Haynes
Sr dec'd & report to Court their action thereupon
