The State of Arkansas

To all persons to whom these presents shall come - I hereby
 know & that whereas James Hairston of the County of Dallas dis-
 interested and valid on or about the day of January A D 1884
 having at the time of his death personal property in this State, which
 may be lost destroyed or diminished in value if Speedy care be not
 taken of the same, to the end thereof that the said property may
 be collected preserved and disposed of according to Law we do
 hereby appoint John A. Soney of the County of Dallas administrator of
 all and singular the goods and chattels rights and credits which
 were of the said James Hairston at the time of his death with full
 power and authority to receive and dispose of the same property
 according to Law, and collect all monies due said deceased
