of the sum of three Hundred Pounds current Money of Virginia to him in hand
paid by the S^d Peter Hairston the Receipt Whereof the S^d Thomas Bush doth hereby
Acknowledge Given Granted Bargained & sold and by these Presents doth Give
Grant Bargain sell Deliver & Confirm to him the S^d Peter Hairston his heirs
& assigns for ever one certain Tract or Parcell of Land containing one Hundred
Acres on the south side of Little Marrowbone Creek & Beginning on said
Little Marrowbone Creek where Randolphs Harmon & Kings old Order line
crosses S. Creek Just below the Main Road, Running thence off a New line Right
Angle from the S. old line & to Extend such Courses & Distance as will include
the S. one hundred Acres of Land with the Plantation whereon the S^d Tho^s Bush
now dwells, with Running three New lines which is part of large Tract of Land
Granted by Patent to Randolphs Harmon & Kings Together with all & singular
the Priviledges & Appurtenances there unto belonging or in any wise appertain-
ing unto the S^d Peter Hairston his heirs & assigns to have and To hold use
Occupy enjoy & Possess the same with every part and Parcell thereof to him the S^d
Peter Hairston his heirs & assigns for ever to the only Proper use & behoof of him

heirs & against the claim & Demand of all other Persons whatsoever Shall & will
