


Franklin County, town, December 24<sup>th</sup> 1792. Surveyed for George Staton

Containing 141 1/4 Acres, N° 484. affixed to John Hook P.R. October 1792. and  
Bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at Pointers in Stephensons line at the Black  
Water Road, Thence with his line along the road S 7<sup>o</sup> 19' 48<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> to a Sycamore Oak in  
Mads line, Thence with it E 11<sup>m</sup> 10<sup>s</sup> to a W.O. on Stephensons B. S 41 E 219<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> to a  
Spanish Oak in William Daddies line, Thence with his line N° 22 E 48<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> to a post Oak

the 2<sup>d</sup> XII<sup>th</sup> of March 1782. N° 11639. on the Branches of Bigg river, and bounded as follows,  
to wit, Beginning at his own and William Gaffells corner W.O. Thence with Gaffells line  
S 62 W 65<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> going a B. to John Joneses corner W.O. Thence with his line S 30 E 30<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> going

Branches of Penn Creek by Virtue of a Land Office Treasury Warrant Granted Charles Copland  
the 2<sup>d</sup> XI<sup>th</sup> June 1782, N° 19 241. Containing 1000 Acres, Beginning at William Hustles corner  
post Oak, Thence with his line W 20<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> to Pointers in his old line, Thence with it N 20 W  
124<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> to a Buck on Penn Creek, Thence with Stephen Stones Line S 50 E 62<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> to his corner  
S 80 E 90<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> said Hustles corner Locust Tree, Thence with his line S 66 E 220<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> going  
two Branches to a B.O. Thence new Line S 60 E 32<sup>m</sup> 2<sup>s</sup> to Manity's corner W.O. Thence with
