Item. I will and bequeath all my real Estate to my Nephew and adopted Son William Hayward Foot to him and his heirs forever. Item, I will and bequeath to my Relation Elizabeth L Thompson five hundred dollars to be paid by my Nephew William H Foot in Consequence of my above bequest to him and it is my desire that the same be paid in twelve months after my death. Item, I will and bequeath to Kitty H Thompson one thousand dollars to be paid by my Nephew William H Foot in Consequence of my bequest to him above, and it is my desire that the same be paid in two years after my death; Item, I will and bequeath to Robert J Thompson three shares of my Potomac Bank stock Item, I will and bequeath to my Relation Kitty Lane three hundred dollars to be paid by my Nephew William H Foot in Consequence of my bequest to him above. Item. I will and bequeath to the Washington Society of Alexandria ten shares of Potomac Bank Stock also my shares in the Potomac Company the annual proceeds of which they are to apply to the education of such poor girls as they may think proper now can I forbear on this solemn occasion to greet them in the name of our holy father and invoke his benediction upon their efforts to rescue from poverty and the sinks of shameless immorality those sweet those wild blossoms which under their fostering care and virtuous inculcations may add much to the store of human happiness. I confine this my donation to my own sex because I believe that human happiness has material dependance upon our moral and religious worth - Item. I hereby - Emancipate my two remaining Servants Adicia & Daniel and I give

and bequeath to the former Seventy dollars & annum to be paid by Nephew
William H Foot in consequence of my bequest to him above and the latter
I will and bequeath the sum of Fifty dollars. It is my will and I charge
it upon my Nephew that he pay the sum bequeathed to Felicia annually
during her natural life because of my before mentioned legacy to him
Item, all the rest and residue of my Estate of what ever kind or
description I will and bequeath to my Nephew and adopted son —
William Hayward Foot, and I do hereby name and appoint him
my sole and only Executor to execute this my Will, December the
Sixteenth One thousand eight hundred and ten,
