I George Hainton Jr. of Henry County Virginia do make and ordain this my last will and Testament. Subject to the payment of my just debts I give and devise to my beloved wife Martha R. all my property and estate of any kind and description to her and her heirs forever. As the executors of this my will I nominate and appoint James M Smith & Wm D Perkins

In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this the 38th day of May in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty one

At a County Court held for Henry County on the 11th day of December 1865

A paper purporting to be the last will and testament of George Hainton Jr. was produced in Court & James M Smith and Christopher J Thomas being examined, testified that they each were well acquainted with the hand writing of said Hainton and from that knowledge and of opinion that said will was wholly written by said George Hainton. Whereupon the Court doth admit said paper to record as the last will and testament of the said George Hainton Jr., and James M Smith one of the executors herein named renounced in open court his right to the office of executor of said Will & the cause is continued till tomorrow for Wm D Perkins the other executor to qualify if he thinks proper. And At a County Court continued and held for Henry County at the Court House on the 12th day of December 1865. Wm D Perkins one of the Executors in the will of George Hainton Jr filed on yesterday, & proved and admitted to record, this day appeared in Court & relinquished his right as such executor & Peter Hainton and Samuel Hainton the brothers of the testator made oath together with Peter W Watkins entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$10,000 conditioned according to law. And thereupon Administration is granted them upon the estate of the said George Hainton Jr deceased with the will annexed. Ordered that Wm D Perkins, Wm A Shifford George R Jones & John Price or any three of them after being first sworn do appraise the estate of the said George Hainton Jr deceased & make report according to law.
