Sarah Rowland's
Will

I Sarah Rowland of the County of Potomac and State of Virginia, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and ordain this my last will and testament hereby revoking any and all other wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1st I give and bequeath to my Executors hereinafter named all of my estate real, personal or of any kind whatsoever either in possession, reversion or remainder in trust for the following purposes to wit: for the support and maintenance of my daughter Charlotte Thompson the wife of Anderson Thompson, and for the support and maintenance of James R. John H. William B. Robert H., Charles A., Henry T., Mary E. Virginia P. and Charlotte Ann, the children of my said daughter Charlotte, and any other children of my daughter that may be hereafter born. my said estate is to be held by my Executors for the above purposes during the life time of my said daughter, it being my object and intention to secure my estate to the use and benefit of my said daughter Charlotte and her children free from the control of her husband and free from the claims of her husband's creditors - I desire my Executors however out of my estate in the first place to appropriate a sufficiency for the decent support and maintenance of my son James during his life time should the provision made for him by the last will of his father James Rowland prove insufficient for that purpose.

Item 2nd after the death of my daughter Charlotte Thompson I desire that all of my estate of every kind be equally divided among all her children who may be alive at the time of her death, but should any child of my daughter Charlotte die, leaving children before the death of my said daughter, then it is my will and desire that the children of such deceased child shall receive the portion of my estate to which such deceased child would have been entitled had such child been living at the time of the death of my daughter Charlotte.

Item 3rd I hereby constitute and appoint my nephew William Kyle and my two grandsons James R. Thompson and John H. Thompson Executors of this my last will and testament and request that they may be permitted to qualify as such without being required to give security - In testimony that this is my last will and testament I do hereto set my hand and affix my seal

Since my Will was made I have acquired some additional estate, and have thought proper to make some charges against several of my grand sons (children of my daughter Charlotte) for whom I have provided in my will. I do therefore ordain the following a Codicil to my Will viz:

That my grandson John H Thompson be charged with two thousand two hundred & ninety six dollars & 86 cents (\$2296.86) as of October 8th 1852. That my grandson W^m B Thompson be charged with Four thousand five hundred & Six dollars & 83 cents (\$4,506.⁸³), as of Oct. 8th 1855.

My grandson Robert H Thompson is indebted to me in a Considerable amount & I am liable as his security for a Considerable amount as yet out standing. It is my desire that an account be taken of such indebtedness & liability & that he be charged with the amount thereof, with interest. And in addition to the above each of my grandsons who participate in the distribution of my estate, shall be charged with Sixty Six dollars & 66 cents, as of this date. Before any of my grandsons shall participate in the distribution of my estate under my Will I require & direct that he account, account first for the charges aforesaid against him, with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, from the dates respectively. In all other respects I will & direct that all my property real & personal of every description whatsoever be held & paid after my death as heretofore provided in my will.
