for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars
to him in hand paid by the said Jacob Shelhorse and
James M. Shelhorse at or before the sealing and delivery of this
Deed the said William Mt Shelhorse doth grant unto the said

Cherry Stone creek containing two hundred and thirty one acres
