

A. J. Mathews & David Charles Tarpe off Jud set aside & Jud confessed with stay of execution till 1 January next.

A deed of conveyance from Alexander Hunter to Martha Hunter proven & recorded.

Callaway & Payne took on Replevy Bond, notice proven & Jud execution for \$50 set 15 Jan'y 1824. Next.

A deed of conveyance from William M. Daniel wife to Allen Barker, further & fully proven & recorded.

The Grand Jury returned into court and having made divers presentments upon which process is awarded, they were discharged.

Bond for 1st & 2nd Rea. Judgment confessed and an injunction granted the defendant, who entered into bond in the penalty of \$82. with John M. Staples his security & ack. the same.

William Perkins & Sanford ^{Esq. James Rogers} Judgment confessed for \$45.57 with interest from 10 March 1823.

A paper purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Ann Beck dec^d was exhibited in court by P. P. Scales the Executor therein named, proved by William A. Hughes one of the subscribing witnesses and adm^d to record, and thereupon the said P. Scales made oath as an Executor and with Wm. M. Sandridge his security entered into bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars and ack. the same.

On motion of P. P. Scales, John Deamey, John Layne, Anthony Johns, Daniel Martin, and William Cornwell or any three of them are appointed commissioners to appraise the personal estate of Ann Beck dec^d and make report to court.

Chambers & Custer. This suit is dropped and by agreement the parties are to pay an equal portion of the costs.

On the application of George Morrison for a road, the report of the commissioners heretofore appointed to view the route proposed in the petition, having been returned, it is ordered that John Edwards through whose land it is proposed to run the same, be summoned to appear here on the first day of September next and to conduct the same.

Commonwealth & King additional plea filed, demurrer thereto and joinder, demurrer overruled. Jud for deft. & appeal taken.

Foster & Booker. Plea waived, & Jud confessed for the debt in the declaration mentioned with stay of execution till Henry October next.

Robert Rowland having been required to enter into a recognizance to keep the peace for the space of twelve months from self in the penalty of Fifty dollars and one security in the sum of fifty dollars entered into said recognizance with Peter Hurston his security each in the penalty of Fifty dollars and acknowledged the same.

George Reynolds having been required to enter into a recognizance to keep the peace for the space of twelve months, entered into a recognizance himself in the sum of Fifty dollars and with Macon Reynolds his security in the like sum of fifty dollars and acknowledged the same.

Orus J. Rowland having been required to enter into a recognizance to keep the peace for the space of twelve months, entered into a recognizance himself in the sum of Fifty dollars with Jeremiah Baker and Peter Hurston his securities each in the sum of twenty five dollars and ack. the same.

Macon Reynolds having been required to enter into a recognizance to keep the peace for the space of twelve months, entered into a recognizance himself in the sum of fifty dollars with George Reynolds his security in the like sum of fifty dollars and ack. the same.

Orus J. Rowland having been fined five dollars for a contempt of court, paid his fine at the Clerk's table, which is ordered to be certified.
