This INDENTURE made and entered into this Eleventh day of June
in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred twenty two between Robert
Bowland and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Henry & State of Virginia of
the one part and George Hairston Jr. of the said County & State of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Robert Bowland & Elizabeth his wife for and in con-
sideration of three hundred dollars Lawfull money of Virginia to them in
hand paid by the said Geo. Hairston Jr. at and before the sealing and deliv-
ery of these presents the receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & confirm
unto the said Geo. Hairston Jr. one undivided fifth part of a certain
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Henry on
Blackberry Creek adjoining the lands of Asaiah Baker German Baker
dec^d and others it being the one undivided fifth part of a tract land laid
to Daniel Baker dec^d by the Will of James Baker dec^d under whose
Will the said Robert Bowland and Elizabeth his wife claims the one
undivided fifth part of said tract or parcel of Land also all the right
title Interest and Claim which the said Robert Bowland and
Elizabeth his wife may have either in law or equity to the Slaves and
other property loaned to the said Daniel Baker deceased during his
natural life by the will of James Baker deceased to him the said George
Hairston Jr. his Heirs and Assigns forever and the said Robert Bowland
& Elizabeth his wife do for themselves their heirs Executors & Adminis-
trators forever warrant and defend the right title Claim and Interest
in and to the said tract or parcel of land together with the slaves and
personal property hereby conveyed unto the said George Hairston Jr. his
Heirs and Assigns forever free from the claim of all and every other person
or persons whatsoever In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands
and seals the day and year first above written
