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Blum v. Staples heirs - This cause this day came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read. The decretal order of the day of _____ and was argued by Council on consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that the demands of the respective claimants be referred to James M. Smith who is appointed a Special Commissioner that he take an account thereof to show which of said demands and the amounts thereof are established by legal and satisfactory proofs and that he report the same to the Court with any matters thought pertinent by himself or required by the parties to be so reported.

Ordered that Anthony M. Dupuy, James M. Smith, George A. Brown and Wm. J. Hamblett or any three of them be appointed Commissioners to settle the account current of George Hinton as Executor of John Burgess decd.

Ordered that William Martin, George Hinton Jr. George A. Brown, Jesse Weston and Wm. J. Hamblett ^{or any three of them} be appointed Comm. to settle the acct current of Anthony M. Dupuy as admr of Wm. Holt decd. and make report to Court

Smith v. Gregg v. Harris attachment - Dismissed by order of Court

Polly Bapett v. Matthews & In Chancery - It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the defendants William Matthews and Elizabeth his wife, Peyton Hunter, Alexander Hunter and Poley Rowland are no inhabitants of this Commonwealth and that the order of publications awarded against them has been duly executed and they still failing to appear the plaintiffs bill as to them is taken for confessed and it moreover appearing to the Court that the subpoena awarded on this cause has been served on the defendants Samuel Burks Pamela his wife, John A. Hanton, Landis P. Strall and Robert T. Woods, more than four months and they failing to appear and answer, the bill as to them is taken for confessed, and now this cause was heard on the bill the exhibits and the arguments of Council on consideration whereof the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that John C. Taylor, James Baker, William F. Mills and William A. Taylor or any three of them who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose do divide the land whereof Peshatan B. Hunter died owner under the Will of his mother Martha Greenlee decd. into six equal parts and apportion one to the complainant Polly Bapett, one to Poley Rowland alias Gray, one to William Matthews in right of his wife Elizabeth Matthews, one to Samuel Burks in right of his wife Pamela Burks, one to John A. Hanton in right of his purchase from Peyton Hunter and an other to the said Hanton in right of his purchase from Alexander Hunter: but the possession of the land aforesaid is to be withheld from the parties aforesaid and each of them and they and each of them are to take no benefit under this decree until they shall have executed, refunding bonds to the Exrs of Martha Greenlee decd. conditioned according to Law. And the Court doth moreover adjudge and decree that Comr Smith do take an account of the administration of Landis P. Strall and John A. Hanton Exrs of Martha Greenlee decd. and the said Hanton as trustee for Peshatan B. Hunter: the S. Commissioner is empowered to examine any of the parties aforesaid on oath and is required to state any matters relating to the accounts aforesaid which he may deem pertinent and which either of the parties may require to be stated. It is further ordered that the Exrs of Martha Greenlee decd. do pay the existing costs of this suit out of any unsold funds in their hands, and that the Comrs herein appointed do report their proceedings under this decree.

On motion of Wm East Jr who entered into bond with Peter Hanton his security, and the Court being satisfied that he is a man of honesty probity and good demeanor and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming he is permitted to keep an ordinary at Henry Court house until Henry May County Court next, and that the unsatisfied laborer claims of Marshall Hanton be transferred to the said William East.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term
